DAY 01 Canada → Beijing

Depart from Vancouver on your international flight to Beijing, beginning your unforgettable journey through China. *Surcharges may apply for departure from other cities in Canada.

DAY 02 Arrival in Beijing

Upon arrival, you will be warmly welcomed by your professional guide and driver. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy free time to rest after your long journey.

DAY 03 Imperial Beijing

After breakfast, visit the Temple of Heaven, where emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties once prayed for good harvests. Today, it is also a lively public park where locals practice Tai Chi, music, and dance. Continue to optional tours of Tiananmen Square and the Forbidden City (USD 60/pp), one of the largest public squares in the world and the former imperial palace of 24 emperors, now home to over one million priceless artifacts. In the afternoon, enjoy an optional tour of visiting the Summer Palace and Peking Duck Dinner (USD 50/pp), a magnificent imperial garden featuring serene lakes, elegant pavilions, and landscaped hills and a classic Beijing culinary experience.

DAY 04 Olympic Legacy & Great Wall

Take photos at the Bird's Nest and Water Cube, iconic venues of the 2008 Beijing Olympics. Visit a Jade Cultural Center to learn about this treasured gemstone and its cultural significance. In the afternoon, explore the Great Wall, one of the world's greatest architectural achievements. In the evening, you may enjoy an optional Beijing Acrobatics Show (USD 50/pp), featuring world-class performances of balance and agility.

DAY 05 Traditional Life & Culture

Visit Tongrentang, a famous traditional Chinese medicine pharmacy, to learn about ancient health practices. In the afternoon, join the optional tour to explore the traditional Hutong neighborhoods and visit the Yonghe Lama Temple (USD 70/pp). Ride a rickshaw through historic alleys, visit a local family, and enjoy a home-style lunch while experiencing authentic Beijing life.

DAY 06 Beijing → Wuxi

After breakfast, take a high-speed train to Wuxi (Tickets Included). Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. In the evening, visit the Qingming Bridge Historic District optional tours (USD 30/pp), where ancient canals, traditional architecture, and Jiangnan water-town charm come alive.

DAY 07 Wuxi → Suzhou

Visit Huishan Ancient Town, known for its ancestral halls representing over 80 Chinese surnames. Stop at a Pearl Processing Center, then visit Li Garden, a beautiful lakeside park with classical Chinese landscaping. Travel onward to Suzhou.

DAY 08 Suzhou → Hangzhou

Visit the Lingering Garden, one of China's four most famous classical gardens (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Tour a Silk Factory to learn about traditional silk production. Continue to Hangzhou and explore West Lake, renowned for its poetic scenery and cultural significance. Enjoy an optional tour boat cruise on West Lake (USD 40/pp) for the best views of its tranquil beauty.

DAY 09 Hangzhou → Shanghai

Visit Meijiawu Tea Plantation to learn about the production of Longjing (Dragon Well) tea. Travel to Shanghai and explore the lively City God Temple Bazaar, filled with traditional architecture, local snacks, and shops. In the evening, experience an optional tour Xintiandi and Huangpu River Cruise (USD 65/pp), where you can admire the stunning contrast between historic Bund buildings and modern Pudong skyscrapers.

DAY 10 Shanghai

Visit Nanjing Road, China's most famous shopping street. Continue to the Bund, known as the "World Architecture Gallery," offering spectacular views of modern Pudong across the river. You may also visit the optional tours Shanghai Historical Museum, Fuxing Park, and Sinan Mansions (USD 40/pp), and enjoy the optional tours ERA Acrobatics Show (USD 55/pp), a world-class performance combining acrobatics and modern technology.

DAY 11 Shanghai → Yichang (Embarkation)

After breakfast, transfer to railway station for your onward journey to Yichang by high-speed train (Included). Upon arrival, you will be transferred by coach to the pier to board your Yangtze River cruise ship. Enjoy dinner on board as you settle in for your voyage.

DAY 12 The Three Gorges Dam

In the afternoon, visit the magnificent Three Gorges Dam, a 5A-rated national landmark and an engineering marvel. For a deeper insight into its construction, you may also opt to experience the Ship Lift (CNY 290 per person), one of the most advanced ship elevators in the world.

DAY 13 Three Gorges: Wu Gorge & Qutang Gorge

Begin your day cruising through the breathtaking Wu Gorge, known for its deep valleys and misty peaks. At Wushan, transfer to a smaller sightseeing boat to explore the stunning Lesser Three Gorges, a 5A-rated scenic area famous for its unspoiled beauty. Alternatively, you may choose the opt for the Mini Lesser Three Gorges excursion (CNY 190 per person) for a more intimate experience. Later, you may opt to visit White Emperor City (CNY 252 per person), a historic site renowned for its cultural significance and panoramic river views.

DAY 14 Fengdu Ghost City

Today, disembark for a shore excursion to Fengdu Ghost City, a 4A-rated attraction known for its intriguing legends, ancient temples, and representations of the afterlife in Chinese folklore. If you prefer a more tranquil experience, you may opt to visit Shuangui Mountain (CNY 150 per person), celebrated for its peaceful scenery and cultural heritage.
